PSAT TESTS GIVEN FOR GRADES 8 – 11: Bethel will administer the **College Board PSAT** (Preliminary Scholastic Aptitude Test) this week (*required*). The PSAT for grades 8 & 9 will be given on Tuesday, Oct. 13, and the test for grades 10 & 11 will be given on Wednesday, Oct. 14. Tests will be given in the morning with regular classes to follow (students are not dismissed early on these days.) *Online students and seniors should attend classes at the normal times.*

RETURN TO CAMPUS UPDATE: We are excited to see more and more of our students back to campus. Please follow these drop-off and pick-up procedures:

-K4 & K5: Park in the **front parking lot**. Wear face coverings and have temperatures checked by office entrance. Walk child to class and dismiss to teacher outside of the classroom.

-1st-8th: Drive through **rear parking lot** **YELLOW** drop-off lane. Wear face covering and stay in vehicle. Child's temperature will be taken before exiting the vehicle. Drop off child in the marked area for the correct grade.

-9th-12: If **walking or bicycling in**, wear face covering onto campus. Have temperature checked **by the office entrance**. Walk directly to first hour class using staircase by room 8 (south side of building). If being **dropped off or parking**, drive through the **rear parking lot** **BLUE** drop-off lane. Park in the spaces marked for high school. Exit vehicle and have temperature checked at the high school entrance gate. Walk directly to first hour class using staircase by room 8 (south side of building).
